Fee: CAD \$5,250

Registration deadlines:

- February 28, 2019 (for June 8 – July 8)
- March 29, 2019 (for July 13 – August 13)

Eligibility:

International students studying medicine or related sciences (typically in their first 2-3 years of undergraduate studies). Participants must be at least 19 years old on the first day of the program, proficient in English, current students enrolled in a non-Canadian educational institution for the duration of the VSP, and have a strong academic background.

To apply to the program, students must contact their home university's international office.
