Born in 1959 in Gaziantep, Dr.Recep GÜLOĞLU studied medicine between 1976 and 1982 at Istanbul Medical Faculty in the University of Istanbul and did his compulsory service between 1982 and 1985 in Regional Malaria Directorate of İçel. He completed his military service in Girne Military Hospital between 1990 and 1991.

Dr.Recep GÜLOĞLU took a degree in surgery at the Department of General Surgery, Istanbul Medical Faculty, University of Istanbul between 1985 and 1989 and became a “General Surgery Specialist”

Dr.Recep GÜLOĞLU continued his academic career working as the “chief assistant” between 1991 and 1997, an associate professor in 1997 and a professor in 2003 at the same faculty. He also holds postgraduate degrees both in Hospital Management and in Higher Education Administration.

Dr.Recep GÜLOĞLU worked as the Chairman of the University hospital between 2009 and 2010 and as “Director of Circulating Capital” of the University of Istanbul between 2010 and 2013.

Dr.Recep GÜLOĞLU worked as the President of Turkish Association of Trauma and Emergency Surgery between 2011 and 2016. He has also served as a member of National Scientific Advisory Board and as the associate editor of Turkish Journal of Trauma and Emergency Surgery, the media organ of Turkish Association of Trauma and Emergency Surgery. He holds the position of editorship of the same journal since 2011.

- Turkish Journal of Trauma and Emergency Surgery has been acknowledged by Index Medicus and Medline since 2001, by Excerpta Medica / EMBASE since 2005 and Science Citation Index-Expanded (SCI-E) as well as Journal Citation Reports / Science Education since 2007.

He is a member of several institutes: European Society for Trauma and Emergency Surgery (ESTES), European Association for Endoscopic Surgery and Other Interventional Techniques, Turkish Surgical Association, Turkish Society of Colon and Rectal Surgery, Turkish Society of Endoscopic and Laparoscopic Surgery.
