Purpose		To provide knowledge on basic legal concepts and rules relating to international migration.					
Course Content (Short Description)		In this lecture, basically the legal aspects of international migration, namely migration movements beyond the national borders will be examined. The related international and national institutions and legislation are planned to be trained. After clarifying basic concepts and entities of the international migration law; it will generally be examined the rights of foreigners and migrants; and spesifically, status, rights and obligations of the foreigners needed international or temporary protection will be analysed. As a tool to combat with irregular migration, the readmission agreements and the problems that can arise from their implementation will be scrutinized. Moreover, human trafficking and migrant smuggling crimes that the irregular migrants are generally the victims of it and the ways to fight against these crimes will be analysed. The international and national migration management and related institutions are also examined.
